Greg Meacham Forensic Accountant

This morning we welcome Greg Meacham, a certified public accountant (CPA) and certified fraud examiner (CFE), who will discuss the world of forensic accounting.

Greg has more than 30 years of investigative experience, first as a police detective and then for 25 years as an FBI agent. After retiring from the FBI, Greg became vice

president for homeland security for Nextel Communications. He now provides investigative and consulting services for MDB International on a wide range of complex white-collar crime and financial fraud investigations.

Greg holds a B.S. in accounting from the University of Maryland, a Masters of Public Administration (MPA) from the University of Southern California, and a Management Certificate from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
