# Robert A. Enholm Woodrow Wilson House

Today we welcome Robert Enholm, executive director of the President Woodrow Wilson House in Washington, D.C. This is the home to which President and Mrs. Wilson retired from the White House in 1921.

Mrs. Edith Wilson lived in the Georgia Revival-style home until 1961, when she bequeathed the home and furnishings to the National Trust for Historic Preservation.

Mr. Enholm became executive director in 2012, after serving at the United Nations following a career in international and corporate law. Mr. Enholm holds a bachelor's degree from the University of California at Davis, and a law degree from the University of California at Berkeley.
