



### **Woodrow Wilson House**



Known as the first modern president and a seeker of peace, President Woodrow Wilson led the United States during a pivotal era that included World War I. When he left office in 1921, he and his wife retired to a home in the Kalorama area of Washington, D.C., which stands today as both a museum and testament to an accomplished statesman.

Wilson's storied career and the home he enjoyed were described on March 13 by Robert A. Enholm, executive director of the President Woodrow Wilson House. Built in 1915, the home contains about 8,000 artifacts and is open to the public for tours and special events.
