Morgan B. Danner Sacred Space in Haiti

This morning we welcome Morgan Danner, an architect with Kerns Group Architects in Falls Church.

She will describe one of her firm's noteworthy (and very challenging) projects: designing a new Holy Trinity Cathedral to replace the previous Episcopal Cathedral destroyed in the 2010 earthquake in Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

The new edifice will be built to U.S. earthquake and hurricane codes and will seat more than 1,200 people.

Morgan is a graduate of Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, N.Y., receiving both her Bachelor's degree in architecture and Master's degree in management and marketing in 2013. An alumna of Langley High School, she now serves as the school's pole vault coach. Morgan is the daughter of Rotarians Pamela Beck Danner and David L. Danner.
