Michael Caplin Tysons Partnership

Today we welcome Michael Caplin, executive director of Tysons Partnership. This is a group of business, government, and community leaders working to redevelop Tysons Corner from a 1970s business park into an exciting and sustainable 21st century downtown.

Mr. Caplin has served as a public defender, federal prosecutor,

performing arts counselor and producer, program director at the Smithsonian Institution, and senior executive and advisor for an array of nonprofit agencies working in the arts, education, and social services.

Mr. Caplin is chairman of the Global Advisory Board of the George Mason University Center for Social Entrepreneurship, and a member of the U.S. Presidential Scholars Commission, appointed by the president in 2010.
