Rotary International is a service organization with 1.2 million members in more than 200 countries. Rotary is a diverse organization, apolitical and nonsectarian, open to all faiths. A Rotary Club's membership should be representative of the community they serve. The **Object of Rotary** is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

**SECOND** High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

**THIRD** The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

**FOURTH** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship and professional persons united in the ideal of service

The Four-Way Test is followed by Rotarians worldwide in their business and professional lives. It was created by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor in 1932 and has since been translated into more than 100 languages and is used by organizations throughout the world.

- 2) Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3) Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
