

- Warm Heads, Warm Hands, Warm Hearts we provide hats and mittens to help keep our community's most vulnerable people warm and safe during winter.
- Haiti Outreach we support development projects in Haiti, mainly community-managed clean water wells and water systems, plus building public schools. Making in-country working visits.
- Ready, Set, Smile We fundraise to ensure dental health screenings for school children who would otherwise not receive care.
