Preliminary Ideas - Richfield Rotary Satellite Group David Butler and Chip Groth June 29, 2017

Following are some preliminary thoughts on the evening Satellite Group and it will fit in and be a part of the Richfield Rotary Club. Changes may occur following additional planning and deliverations:

- 1. All new members will be full members of Richfield Rotary Club and will pay dues as regular members. The club will need to take a look at the dues structure for younger members. (Currently, dues for members 35 and under are \$45.00 per quarter, while dues for members over age 35 are \$65.00 per quarter.)
- 2. If there are current club members who want to be a part of the Richfield Rotary Club, but who for one reason or another prefer to just attend an evening meeting once or twice a month instead of the morning meetings, the club will allow members to retain membership and attend the evening meetings.
- 3. The evening group will focus less on speakers and more on planning for the undertaking of local community service projects.
- 4. Any member of the club may attend either morning or evening meetings or both.

- 5. Members will be encouraged to attend at least one meeting a month, either a morning meeting or an evening meeting.
- 6. The President of the Richfield Rotary Club club shall appoint from its membership a person to act as chair of the evening group to preside at the meetings and to handle projects that the group decides to take on.
- 7. The evening group shall have the authority to plan its own projects and to designate members of its group to handle the implementation of its projects. The evening group shall invite all members of the club (morning and evening) to participate in its projects.
- 8. The leaders of the evening group shall keep the president of the club advised as to its activities.
- 9. Activities of the evening group will be reported in the Club newsletter.

These are just some beginning thoughts and will need to receive additional deliberation.
