# Chili Cook-Off Official Policies and Procedures

## Sponsored by: Castro Valley Rotary Club

Friday, May 8, 2015. 5:00pm – 8:00pm  
Rowell Ranch Rodeo Park

<b>Participants</b>	Area residents, non-profit organizations and businesses are welcome to participate. Spaces will be assigned on first come, first serve basis.
<b>Logistics</b>	The public will buy tasting tickets from the ticket booth. Each participant will collect one ticket per taste and deposit it in a Taste Ticket bucket that will be provided.
<b>Booths</b>	Each contestant will be provided with a 10 x 10 area.
<b>Cost</b>	Entry Fee - \$50.00.
<b>Set-up Check In</b>	Water supplies should be arranged beforehand to suit individual needs. Check-in will begin at 2 pm. Please drop off supplies at your space, then park your car in the upper parking lot outside the gate.
<b>Hours of Operation</b>	Chili for the public tasting should be ready to serve at 5 pm. The cook-off will officially end at 8 pm. Chili for judging will be collected at 5 pm.
<b>Trash Collection</b>	Each organization must provide 2 large trash containers.
<b>Supplies</b>	We suggest you bring scissors, tape, tacks and string for decoration. Please remember towels and napkins.

**The following rules are to be adhered to by all cooks and/or their assistants.**

1. Chili to be prepared prior to the actual cook-off. Each contestant must prepare a minimum of: one half-gallon COMPETITION chili, and ten or more gallons PRECOOKED chili for public tasting. All chili must be homemade. Store-bought chili will be disqualified.
2. Contestants will be responsible for supplying all of their cooking utensils and booths. Please bring a propane stove as electric outlets are not available. The Rotary Club will provide a 10 x 10 ft area for each contestant and will supply tasting cups and spoons for the public.
3. There will be a mandatory Cooks Meeting at 4:30 pm on site to explain the rules and judging procedures.
4. Coordinators will randomly assign a letter and competition chili container to each contestant, into which the contestant will put his/her competition chili and bring it to the collection table.
5. All contestants will be given an official Taste Ticket bucket. Contestants must use this for the collection of tasting tickets.
6. Please do not bring outside alcohol to the event. Beer and wine are available for purchase.
7. Have fun entertaining your friends and neighbors during the event!!!!

### **Judging Procedure and Criteria**

This Chili Cook-Off will use a double-blind judging procedure, with an independent non-participating coordinator.

- Competitor's chili entries will be collected in standard containers identified only by a letter (A, B, C, etc.). (Cooks will receive these containers at the Cooks Meeting.)
- Judges will not observe the collection process.
- Entries will be randomly assigned to two groups for the first round of judging. First round judges will also be randomly assigned to each group.
- Judges will assess the chili entries on the following criteria:
  - The texture of the meat (not too tough or too mushy)
  - Good flavoring and chili pepper taste (not too hot or too mild)
  - Consistency of the mixture (Not too thick or too thin)
  - The blend of spices. How well have they permeated the meat?
  - Aroma.
- Five entries from each group will advance to the final round, with a new set of judges, who will select the winners based on the same criteria used in the first round.
