Youth

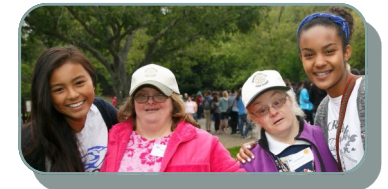
School supplies— provide backpacks with school supplies before school begins
