Demotion Party – Standard Operating Procedure

- 1. Set date (end of June)
 - a. Ideal: Last Tuesday in June (dark during the day)
 - b. check date w George
- 2. Mike at Miralgia caterers (Rotarian: always gives good deal and great food) easy to work with...
 - a. 510 483 9210, mike@cateringandmore.com
 - b. George supplies wine
 - c. buy and bring water and soft drinks (not everyone drinks wine)
- 3. Invite (well in advance) incoming District Governor and Past Dist. Gov. for installation of board and officers.
- 4. New Board (who are they) be sure they attend
 - a. Pins for new board members (order from Russell Hampton or any RI source (web)
- 5. New Officers (new treasurer and pres. elect after Cliff...)
 - a. Pins for Pres, Pres. Elect Sec and Treas.
 - b. Past pres. pin for Dick (I will order blue badge that says past pres.)
- 6. Theme and skit (to be determined by past president's committee)
 - a. Call a meeting of past presidents (bring beer, soft drinks and light refreshments)
 - b. Assign tasks
 - c. Collect stories from wife or others to use during skit/roast and incorporate into theme.
 - d. Develop program
- 7. Banner (if necessary)
 - a. Ben (as soon as possible) his prices are very reasonable and often he donates.
- 8. Display of photos (see Bruce for copies) of highlights of this year's meetings and events
 - a. Place on easel at sign in table
- 9. Fliers and email to members about date/time/ cost (usually about \$40.00)
 - a. Let members know if you want participation or special dress code etc.
- 10. Get name from Prez to engrave on Goe Award.
- 11. Flowers for spouse.

 - f. 7:50 Installation of new officers
 - g. 8:00 Cliff to make closing remarks
- 14. THE FUN STUFF:
 - a. Need to acknowledge achievements;
 - 1. Great programs
 - 2. New members
 - 3. Successful BBQ fundraiser
 - 4. Best ever Chili Cook Off
 - 5. Great Parade
 - 6. Belize project
 - b. Duck theme:

1. Dress Dick as a "Quack" in a white lab coat with doctor stuff. Put sign on his back "QUACK"

2. Have someone on one side of the stage read the "Farmers Almanac" throughout the skit. Make a large book showing audience "Farmer's Almanac"
