**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
CASTRO VALLEY ROTARY CLUB COMMUNITY FOUNDATION**

**ARTICLE I: NAME OF CORPORATION**

1. The name of the corporation is CASTRO VALLEY ROTARY CLUB COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (hereinafter "corporation").

**ARTICLE II: PURPOSE OF CORPORATION**

2. This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the non-profit public benefit corporation law for charitable purposes.
3. The specific purpose of this corporation shall be to benefit the community of Castro Valley, California, currently an unincorporated area inside of Alameda County (with current zip codes of 94546 and 94552) as follows:
  - A. To receive unrestricted funds, unrestricted contributions, and unrestricted bequests, all of which shall be applied to a permanent endowment, distributions from which shall be used for projects and purposes solely for the benefit of the community of Castro Valley, as directed by the Rotary Club of Castro Valley through the Rotary Club of Castro Valley's board of directors and the club membership. All such unrestricted funds shall be used for charitable purposes inside of Castro Valley as approved by the board of directors of the Rotary Club of Castro Valley and by the Rotary Club of Castro Valley.
  - B. To receive restricted funds, restricted contributions, and restricted bequests if those restrictions are approved in writing, in advance by the board of trustees of the Castro Valley Rotary Club Community Foundation.
  - C. This corporation is organized exclusively for the above charitable purposes within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Despite any provisions in these articles, the corporation shall not, except in insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that do not further the purposes of this corporation, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from the Federal Income Tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provisions in any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Internal Revenue Code Section 170(c) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

**ARTICLE III: AGENT FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS**

4. The name of the corporation's initial agent for service of process is James J. Phillips, 4900 Hopyard Road, Suite 260, Pleasanton, California 94588.

**ARTICLE IV: PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

5. The initial street and mailing address for the principal office of the corporation shall be located at 3203 Castro Valley Boulevard, Castro Valley, California 94546.

**ARTICLE V: TAX-EXEMPT STATUS OF CORPORATION**


6. Tax-Exempt Status.
  - A. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or other attempts to influence legislation or bond or parcel tax measures, and this corporation shall not participate or intervene (including publishing or distributing statements) in any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.
  - B. All corporate property is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes set forth in Article II. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any of its directors, trustees, officers, members, or to any individual.
  - C. On the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after payment of or adequately providing for the debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation, the remaining assets of this corporation shall be distributed to the Rotary Club of Castro Valley, provided it has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or to any other non-profit corporations serving exclusively Castro Valley, California.
  - D. This corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on the undistributed income imposed by Internal Revenue Code Section 4942 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
  - E. The corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4941(d) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
  - F. The corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4943(c) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.


- G. The corporation will not make investments in a manner that would subject it to tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 4944 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- H. The corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4945(d) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.


