

The Rotary Club of Dublin Foundation 2025 Scholarship Application



The Rotary Club of Dublin Foundation is a California charitable corporation focused on meeting the needs of the residents of Dublin and neighboring communities. The Foundation annually awards scholarships to seniors in the Dublin high schools based on academic success, community service and involvement, school participation, financial need and likelihood of future success in academic or vocational pursuits. This year, the Foundation is awarding approximately \$20,000 in total scholarship awards in the following categories:

For students attending a 4-year University:

- One *Dave Burton Memorial Scholarships* to an exceptional college-bound senior.
- Several Dublin Rotary Scholarships to additional college-bound seniors.
- One or more \$500 *Ted Hoffman Jr. Memorial Scholarships* to college-bound seniors who are active members of an Interact Club.

For students attending a trade school, apprenticeship program, certificate program through a community college, a 2- or 3-year arts program, or a related activity:

- One or more \$1500 Chris Kinzel Memorial Vocational Scholarships to students bound for vocational or trades school.
- One or more \$500 *Ted Hoffman Jr. Memorial Scholarships* to college-bound seniors who are active members of an Interact Club.

Recipients may only receive one scholarship as determined by the Rotary Foundation of Dublin Scholarship Committee. Please attach this page and the following information in a single combined PDF document:

- Application Page: Please be sure you have filled out each section completely.
- Grades: Your most recent transcript of grades from your school
- <u>Community Service</u>: Your history of community service.
- <u>Financial Needs:</u> All facts you would like us to consider in determining financial needs.
- <u>Personal Statement:</u> An autobiographical statement including why you expect to succeed in school and in life and how this scholarship will help. You may also include here your involvement in clubs, athletics, and other school activities.

Your application must be received by midnight on **Sunday, April 13, 2025.**

Only e-mail applications will be accepted. Please submit all requested information – This page, Transcript, Community Service, Financial Needs, and Personal Statement in a **single combined PDF** document to the Dublin Rotary Scholarship committee at dublinrotaryscholarship@gmail.com. Each submittal will be acknowledged via email within two days.

Scholarships will be awarded as a part of your school's awards or graduation ceremonies.
