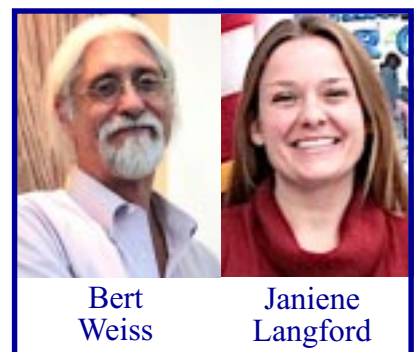

March 19, 1935 – January 11, 2016



Steve Rubiolo Jr. of Hayward passed away peacefully on January 11, 2016 at the age of eighty.

Steve is survived by his wife of 32 years Milly, his brothers Don (Georgia) Rubiolo, Richard (Shari) Rubiolo, his daughter Dawn Dreyling, three step children Kurt (Darcelle) Glazier, Hal (Jan) Angus, and Gail (John) Wilson. Preceding Steve in his passing was his beloved son Steven W. Rubiolo (3/21/85). He is survived by nine grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Steve graduated Hayward High School in the class of 1953. He was a local photographer for 56 years. Steve was an active member of the Hayward Rotary Club having been a past president.

He was also a longtime member of the downtown Hayward merchants association and chamber of commerce. He was also very involved with law enforcement being a member of the Alameda County Honorary Deputy Sheriffs Association and past president of the Hayward Crime Stoppers.
