HOW TO MAKE UP REGULAR MEETINGS

The membership of any active, senior active, or past service member, except as provided in this Article, who is absent from four consecutive regular meetings of this club shall automatically terminate, unless such absence is made up as hereinafter provided, or he is excused by the board for good and sufficient reason.

Any member absent from a regular meeting of this club may make up such absence by attendance at a regular meeting of any other Rotary club or a provisional Rotary club within the two weeks immediately preceding and after an absence and be given full credit for attendance in this club, provided notice of such attendance is given to this club by the secretary of the club visited or the member may make his own report. The following are considered make-ups:

- Attending meetings of active committee(s) or other official Rotary business,
- Bringing a guest (potential new member), and
- Attending a District meeting or function.

The membership of any active, senior active, or past service member, except as hereinafter provided, whose percentage of attendance is less than sixty percent during the first or second six month period of the club's fiscal year shall automatically terminate, unless he is excused by the board for good and sufficient reason.

Any senior active or past service member who, because of protracted ill health or impairment, is physically unable to comply with the provisions of this section may, during the period of its continuance, upon application to the board, be excused from complying with attendance requirements and in his absence shall not be computed in the attendance record of the club.

Any senior active or past service member who has been a member of one or more Rotary clubs for in the aggregate twenty years or more, and has reached the age of sixty-five years, may notify the secretary in writing of his desire to be excused from complying with attendance requirements. If approved by the board, such member's attendance or absence shall not be computed in the attendance record of the club.
