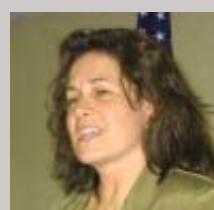

MAIMONIDES 8 STEPS OF CHARITY!

DARYL SAVAGE not only took over the stage from President LE but also set the stage for the theme of the day - Maimonides 8 Steps of Charity. DARYL described her pride for her son JACOB who is becoming Bar Mitzvah and who is learning from the 12th century



philosopher's writings as well as in practice by feeding the homeless. For all of you modern philosophers the following are the 8 Steps: 1) The first is to give reluctantly; 2) The second is to give cheerfully but not sufficiently; 3) The third is to give cheerfully and sufficiently and without being asked; 4) The fourth is to give cheerfully and sufficiently without being

asked, but to put it in the recipient's hand in such a way as to make him feel ashamed; 5) The fifth grade of charity is to let the recipient know who the donor is but let the donor know the identity of those receiving charity; 6) The sixth grade of charity is to know who is getting your charity but to be unknown to them; 7) The seventh is to have neither the donor nor the recipient aware of the other's identity; 8) But the eighth - and the highest - grade of charity is to forestall it completely by enabling your fellow humans to have the wherewithal to earn a livelihood.
