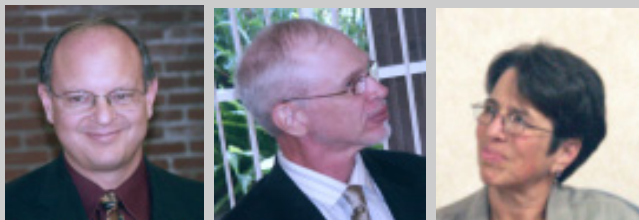

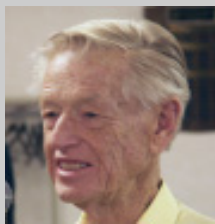


Outgoing Rotoract President, SILVIA CONSTOLE-BATILANA introduced

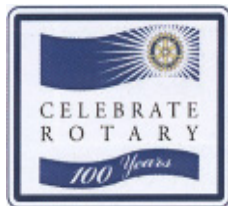
