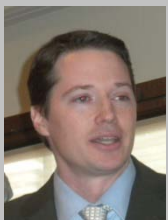
"WE CARE" GURU DICK FREEMAN ANNOUNCED

DIANA noted that the County processes 45,000 cases a year...and that there are 500 employees and the budget is \$85 million annually. (I don't know about you, but that is rather mind-boggling information.)

Following their opening comments...Carr "*Experience counts*" Rosen..."*Violence in the County is the overriding issue*" DIANA presented some very challenging questions including:

*"Do you support the death penalty?
When can juveniles be charged as adults?

Is it appropriate to withhold cases from certain judges?
When is DNA analysis proper?
How will you cut \$11.7 million from your budget?"*

Following the formal program, the floor was opened for questions, which included:

*Where do you stand on the three strikes law?
What specific budget cuts will you make?
What social services cuts are you in favor of?*
