

for the day who provided us with interesting insight into the clean energy revolution. After graduating from UCLA Jorg has been involved in large scale worldwide alternative energy projects. Currently he is the chief commercial officer for a company called Primus Power.





storage device that is the critical element for renewable energy adoption. After reviewing the historical fits and starts with political influence Jorg showed us the current economic status of commercial electric power generators. The key aspect now of solar energy is that, without subsides and incentives, it is highly competitive in generation cost with the historic

alternatives. Solar power's main weakness is that it cannot produce electric power during the whole of the day. That makes the need for some means of electric power storage a crucial element in its adoption. NiCad batteries have limited duration and capacity. Primus Power has a new device called a flow battery which offers a long term solution for electric power storage that is environmentally friendly, easy to manufacture and, very importantly, does not represent a fire risk. ROB LANCEFIELD asked if this was a good solution for primitive countries like Afghanistan and the speaker indicated that any country with a high dependence on off grid diesel power generation would be good candidates for solar power coupled with this new technology.
