He then discussed the Rotary Foundation and the End Polio Campaign, how Nigeria is now polio free, and the only two countries left with polio

are Pakistan and Afghanistan. A prime example of the success of the campaign occurred in Sri Lanka during the Civil War between the Sinhalese and the Tamil residents in the north. Rotary was able to help obtain a three day cease-fire to enable the inoculation of both the Tamil and Sinhalese children, leading directly to the elimination of polio in Sri Lanka.
