trees blooming in Atlanta. They bought and planted their first dogwood upon their return. After decades of collecting dogwoods, they now have 13.

TODAY'S PROGRAM

ED SHIKADA introduced **Dean Batchelor**, the Director of Utilities for Palo Alto, who is responsible for all of Palo Alto's utilities (water, gas, electricity, garbage & recycling, stormwater, sewage and fiber optics). Dean provided an update



on the Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) (aka "smart" meters) that will be



installed in all residential buildings by year-end. These will allow residents to monitor their utility usage in real time. Dean also talked about Palo Alto's plan to modernize the electric grid to support increased electric demand and

to accommodate state-of the art technology. This project includes modernizing the electrical distribution system (e.g., substation, poles, cables, transformers), integrating new technology (e.g., AMI, fault indicators, remote switching, fuse savers), and supporting green customer technologies (e.g., solar, EV chargers, heat pump water heaters, etc.). The city is currently piloting its electrical distribution system upgrade project and estimates it will take until 2031 to 2033 to be completed. The plan is to combine each home's electrical grid update with their fiber optic update to minimize disruption. Keep a look out for new poles and transformers coming to your neighborhood soon.
