The virtual attendees were Mayor Greer Stone (Incumbent), Doria Summa, and Cari Templeton.

SALLY TOMLINSON introduced the moderator, award-winning journalist **Gennady**



Sheyner who covers local and regional politics, housing, transportation and other topics for the Palo Alto Weekly, Palo Alto Online and their sister publications.

Questions were posed to each of the candidates on housing, rail crossings, retail policy, rental registry,

Palo Alto Airport extension, sustainability/fossil fuels and priorities.

In the responses by the candidates there was not a great deal of dissension, challenges, outbursts or interruptions, though some different priorities. It seems that the biggest challenges facing the city are the rail crossings, housing and rental considerations, safety and the decaying Cubberley buildings.
