#### **BILL JOHNSON**

introduced our speaker Elena Kadvany, San Francisco Chronicle Food Reporter. BILL hired Elena to work at the Palo Alto Weekly in 2013 after she graduated from USC.

He had many stories of how quickly she was



promoted and how effective she was as a reporter covering school board meetings, a trial, but always with a love of writing about food. She worked at the Weekly and the Country Almanac for eight years and now has been a Food reporter at SF Chronicle for four years.

Elena explained that she is not a food critic, writing restaurant reviews of individual restaurants but a food reporter who writes about bigger issues



affecting the restaurant industry as well as doing investigative reporting about what might be happening with a particular restaurant location, for example the Cliffhouse. She spoke of some restaurants focusing on a "Tasting menu" as a way to remain profitable with the increasing expenses of labor, ingredients, utilities.

She stressed if there is a restaurant you love, help it, by going there and spreading the word. Just as newspapers need subscribers, restaurants need diners. Many restaurants have been forced to provide GrubHub for their

diners even though they lose money on every purchase since Grubhub takes 30%.

Elena grew up in Menlo Park and knows that there are many good restaurants on the Peninsula.

When questioned as to why critics seem to review more San Francisco and East Bay restaurants, she said that we needed to count the reviews and that there have been a number of Peninsula reviews too. A favorite restaurant of hers is in San Mateo, a ramen noodle restaurant, Kajiken.
