A. FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. Minutes – Approve the board meeting minutes from May. The minutes will be posted as a link on the website for members.

B. Treasurer's Report (Bill is unable to attend so below are his comments/concerns)

- 1. Need to finalize what David and Donna are using their Duck monies for. Tickets purchased in name of SF Rotary. Chris to talk to Barry to make it so. They kicked around a lot of things, but I am not sure anything was final. If it was, I missed it.
- 2. Need to address the non-payment of Jordan's dues and meals balance which Mike Connelly said he would pay. Does someone want to follow up or do we want to write it off and move on?
- **3.** I am in no rush to spend the "future" Uncorked reserve but if we do my vote would be Rotary sponsored signage along the riverfront tied into the trestle bridge project, but I could be swayed for something else as long as it is for something that will continue to give us exposure and not a once and done project where the sponsorship dies after the project is complete.
- **4.** Traffic Planning and 1st Colonial have not paid their Uncorked Sponsorships yet (\$500 and \$5,000, respectively). Still time but want to emphasize it to everyone. Tim to follow-up with TPD.
- 5. Expectations should be set lower for AAF in 2023 unless donations significantly increase. For 2022 we had a \$3k carry over to fund the project from the prior year which we do not have this year, nor do we have the \$700 in Lew Deery memorial donations. Dawn is aware of those issues. Talking about giving via Paypal.
- **6.** Placemat revenue is slightly lower than one would anticipate because 1st Colonial and Traffic Planning were billed at the old rate of \$75. This will change for next year.
- 7. The Ambler Savings Uncorked Sponsorship check has not been cashed yet just because Dan and I had not caught up with each other. He has had it for two weeks now, so I am sure he has just been too busy.
- 8. Jason could manage Facebook and donations.
- 9. Ashley Kolpak to speak to group from Tri-County network to be non-profit partner to help with fund-raising.
- 10. We need to decide what Foundation fund Donna wants the regular 50/50 funds to be donated towards once we have the final tally currently at \$1,299. Donna agreed to give to AAF. We have the weeks of 6/14, 6/21 and 6/28 to include. My recommendation would be to go with \$1,400 based on weekly collections.
- **11.** For the pancake breakfast funds available to donate, I would recommend either round up or down from the net amount to make it easier on the committee to distribute. I don't care which way we go with the \$7000.
- 12. On the attached outstanding check list there are some I think need follow up to see if there is an issue (those highlighted). The first one is the third place 4 Way Speech contest student from the year before. Hope on the Hill Uncorked donation, what is their issue? Barry to contact them. Western Ctr why haven't they cashed their check yet. Tom to email Chef Arnt. Paul ?? is the Holiday Light Contest winner. Can some members follow up with some of these?
