Madilyn's Story

Brittany's Hope is a non-profit 501 (c) 3 organization dedicated to aiding and facilitating adoptions of special needs children from around the world. Unicef's latest figures estimate that more than 153 million children languish in institutions and orphanages around the world; typically in countries which are under-developed and plagued by poverty, social restrictions, and war. If you are an abandoned child with special needs of any kind, chances are slim you will receive the medical care you need to reach your potential.

WATER PROJECT INFO:

Rotary Clubs' of Warminster and Hatboro, PA along with The Rotary Club of Ruiru in Kenya have collaborated to bring the life force of water to the Kenyan people. The coalition has already completed a water storage and filtration system. Now the Home of Hope orphanage for boys will begin its water bottling project allowing the boys to sell clean water to the community and fund the orphanage.

Madilyn a child afflicted with Cerebral Palsy was diagnosed at a very young age with low motor coordination which causes developmental delays. She requires weekly assistance services such as physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, and signing therapy. At 2 months of age, Madilyn was diagnosed with Periventricular Leukomalacia (PVL) which is a white-matter brain injury that affects infants. This condition involves deterioration of small areas of brain tissue that create small holes in the brain.

Madilyn requires harnesses and special needs chairs which will allow her to move more freely and exercise her legs while she grows and learns to walk. In spite of her condition, Madilyn maintains a happy, playful and content disposition. Madilyn's smile has warmed the hearts of her family and friends that surround her.

The Warminster Rotary Club Foundation's goal this year is to improve the quality of life for Madilyn and her loving family. The proceeds of the event will be used to support the efforts to provide special equipment for both home and daycare use. Without this equipment Madilyn's progression; physically, socially, and emotionally will not mature at the correct rate.
