Ben McMullen is presenting information on Sierra Nevada Corp (SNC), not the brewery. Sierra Nevada is a privately owned defense contractor that was founded in 1963. The current owners are from Turkey.

Their corporate headquarters are in Sparks, NV. They have facilities in 19 US states and in England, Germany, and Turkey. Eighty percent of their business is US Govt Direct.

They have averaged a 25 percent growth rate for the past 5 years with orders in 2016 totaling \$2 billion. They have no long term debt.

Their wholly-owned operating subsidiaries are: ESEN in Ankara, Turkey; 328 Support Services in London and Germany; 3S Certification and 3S Engineering in Wichita, KS; Straight Flight in Englewood, CO; Orbital Technologies Corp and HMA Fire in Madison, WI; Sierra Completions in Colorado Springs, CO; and Kutta Technologies and Kutta Radio in Phoenix, AZ.

In Colorado and Centennial, SNC has 57 local partners/suppliers. In 2015 to 2017 they had over \$60 M in orders/revenue. They have created over 1200 jobs in the community. Key partners are Ball Aerospace, Blue Canyon Technologies, Boeing, Broad Reach Engineering, Lockheed Martin, Northrup Grumman, Special Aerospace Services, and United Launch Alliance.

Their Space Systems enterprise area, located in Louisville, CO, is concerned with spacecraft systems, space technologies, space exploration systems, and propulsion and environmental systems. The space exploration systems is working on the Dream Chaser® Space Utility Vehicle.

The Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR), located in Englewood, Centennial, and Colorado Springs, is concerned with aviation, tactical solutions, logistics, technical operations, and advanced development.

The aviation systems of ISR worked with the State of Colorado and developed an aircraft for spotting forest fires before they get too large. California is now using the same technology.

The logistics group, located in Centennial, does worldwide comprehensive supply chain management, full spectrum global maintenance, integrated logistics engineering, and support different airframes around the globe.

The technical operations and production located at Centennial Airport has over 180,000 sq ft of production floor space in ten hangers. They are AS 9100/9110 certified. They are a FAA Part 145 repair station. They have received the FAA Diamond Award for 5 consecutive years.
