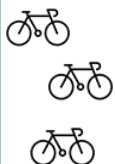

PROJECT WORTHMORE

Denver Mile High Rotary partners with Cherry Creek Rotary



PROJECT WORTHMORE

Where: Project Worthmore is located at 1666 Elmira Street, Aurora
What: They need a total of 8 volunteers - 3 to help with packaging and 5 to help with contactless delivery.

When: The first Monday of every month:

10:30am - 12:00pm: Food Packaging. Two volunteers will work in a well-ventilated room to put together boxes of food for the refugee families.

12:00pm - 2:30/3:00pm: Deliver boxes of food to families within a 3-mile radius of Project Worthmore. Maps will come with food but GPS navigation recommended.

Needed: A minimum of 2 baggers and 3 drivers each first Monday of the month. Project Worthmore is a local non-profit that serves the refugee community in the Denver metro area by providing a dental clinic, language classes, food for their community, as well as other services. Denver Mile High Rotary (through our Local Community Service Committee) has signed up to volunteer the **first Monday of each month** to help with food packaging and/or contactless deliveries.
