I had two takeaways from the Institute:



# **Denver Mile High Rotary Upcoming Programs**

**September 12th** - Joshua Hunt, CEO and Founder of Trelora will be our speaker. Joshua will describe his personal and business journeys, and his efforts to reshape the traditional real estate experience, having developed a vision on how to offer buyers and sellers a more efficient, less expensive real estate experience through the use of technology and task specialization.


**September 19th** - Rhys Duggan, of Revesco Properties will be our speaker. Revesco is a nimble boutique real estate investment and development group with offices in Denver and Vancouver, B.C. In 2015, Revesco Properties spearheaded the acquisition of Elitch Gardens from Orlando based CNL Financial Group. Earlier this year, the City and County of Denver in conjunction with the Downtown Denver Partnership approved an amendment to the Downtown Area Plan for the remaining undeveloped area of the Central Platte Valley, including the Elitch's property. Rhys Duggan, Founder/CEO/President of Revesco Properties will tell us what this means for the future of this key piece of Downtown Denver and what plans lie ahead.

**September 26th - Lisa Flores, Treasurer and District 5 Representative** of the Denver Public Schools' Board of Education will be our speaker. The Denver Board of Education is the policymaking body for Colorado's largest school district, and the board's powers and duties are established in state law. Join us to discuss the current status of DPS and its vision, Every Child Succeeds.

**October 3rd -** Hassan Latif, Executive Director of Second Chance Center will be our speaker. Founded in 2012, Second Chance Center is community re-entry agency dedicated to the successful transition of People returning from incarceration. SCC has grown to become the preeminent reentry agency in Colorado, maintaining a recidivism rate of under 11% for participants involved in SCC programs.
