What a wonderful benefit to the City of Denver...and a great challenge he has taken on. Thanks to Kevin and all others who were involved in having him speak at our meeting.

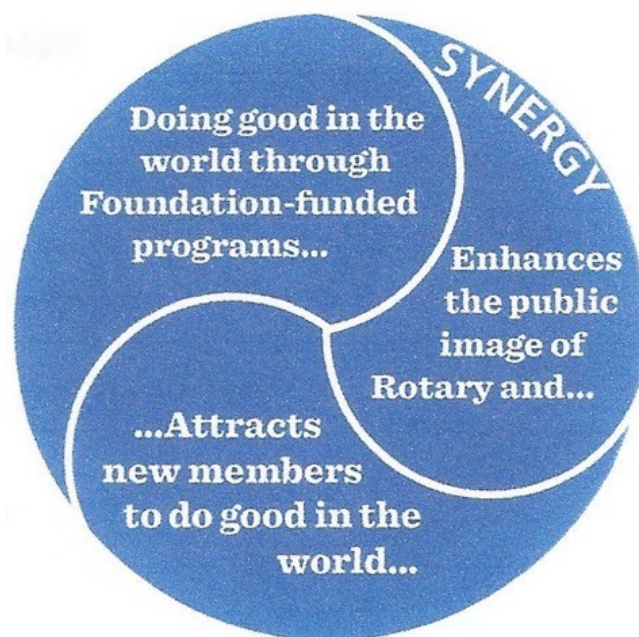
