November 30th Kara Lapso Kara Lapso will speak about Shelter Box - We know of the disaster of Haiti from Hurricane Matthew, but an earth-quake hit Ecuador in April of 2016 and some other current active deployments include Chile, Nepal, Malawi for flooding and many others. Each Box costs about \$1,000. ShelterBox aid is tailored to a disaster but typically includes a disaster relief tent for a family, thermal blankets and ground-sheets, water storage and purification equipment, solar lamps, cooking utensils, a basic tool kit, mosquito nets and children's activity pack.

December 7th - We welcome our very own District Governor - Bill Downes! Bill will update us about what is going on in our Rotary District as well as Rotary in the United States and Globally.
