DMHR Jam Sales and Coat Donations

Thanks to our club members for supporting our first-year jam sales. We netted approximately \$1600+, selling more than 400 jars.

Top seller/buyers were Marcus, Allesandro, Jim Strong, and Noreen. Special thanks to Marcus for conducting the process primarily on his own from start to finish. Thanks also to Noreen for helping coordinate purchases being donated to Metro Caring's food bank. In general, the jam was much easier to move around compared to the citrus sales of prior years.

Because there was some confusion regarding the "gift boxes" associated with the sales, please consider the following and call out if you have any questions or still need boxes. The gift boxes, which hold 3 jars, were an additional \$1 per box. If you bought 12 jars and wanted 4 gift boxes, this subtracted \$4 for our net. Many (like me) realized we didn't need the gift boxes as the jam would be distributed in 'ones-ies and twos-ies' to friends and family. As a result, many of the boxes were returned which increased our net by \$60+. Nevertheless, some still wanted the gift boxes. If you still want gift boxes, please let me know how many in the next few days. We plan to pick them up and distribute next week.
