George Schiel



George Schiel was a member of DMHRC in the 1990s and 2000s. There are still a large number of us who fondly remember his quiet calm participation in the club's activities. He was the treasurer of the DMHR Foundation.

Professionally, George was a senior executive with Children's Hospital and then started up a major medical and airport business called Hospital Shared Services (later called HSS) which provide labor and

unique skills to the Health Care and Transportation Industries, mostly in Denver but across the USA.. He was its president.

When George's Alzheimers condition became too severe and he could no longer drive from the South East to Downtown, he had to resign from the Club. That must have been about 5 - 6 years ago. George was always part of my Rotary fly fishing outings and he always caught more fish than most. George lost his battle with Alzheimer's two weeks ago and there was a service for him Sunday, August 23.


