


This would be the first playground in Aurora of its kind. Accessible or inclusive playgrounds also accommodate parents and grandparents with disabilities.

There are over 500 kids with disabilities in five elementary schools, two middle schools and two high schools within the two-mile radius of the park.




The Aurora Rotary Foundation, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) corporation and all donations are tax deductible.

The site will include a gathering space, a sensory garden, play equipment, musical instruments and features numerous sensory experiences.



FUNDING


