WHAT ROTARIANS ARE DOING:

Scholarships Awarded! Mike McHugh and Dennis Hein met and sent out letters notifying 6 students they won the \$2,000 Harold Carver Scholarships and 2 Students they won the \$1,000 Al Kilpatrick Grants for the upcoming year. **Jim Gracey, Don Storey, Dan Hershberger, Linda Nedved, April Fratzke Bill Edwards Dan Hershberger, Matt Weller Rich Worley and Kathy Periman** reviewed the 13 applications we received for the granting of up to five two thousand dollar Harold Carver academic scholarships and five one thousand dollar Al Kilpatrick vocational grants to area students pursuing additional education beyond high school on March 21. The winners of the Scholarships are:

Harold Carver \$2,000 Scholarships: **Grace Davis** from A. West going to U of Arkansas; **Bethany Hansen** Arvada West going to CU Boulder; **Miriam Perez** from Pomona to CU Boulder; **Luci Holland** from A. West to Mines or CU; **Cassidy DiTirro** from Pomona going to Regis and **Elena Naccarato** from Arvada West going to Colorado Christian U. Six two thousand dollar Harold Carver Scholarships were awarded as we had a tie for the number 5 spot and had just two applicants for the one thousand dollar Kilpatrick vocational grants.

Al Kilpatrick \$1,000 Vocational Grants: **Kate Henderson** from Warren Tech to Johnson & Wales; **Luke Hawthorne** from Warren Tech going to Grand Canyon U.

All recipients have been invited along with their families to attend our annual picnic July 18 at the Allen House.

Arvada Wheat Ridge Service Ambassadors for Youth: **Don Storey**, our representative for Arvada Wheat Ridge Service Ambassadors for Youth (AWRSAY) reports: AWRSAY has once again been chosen, along with four other non-profits, to compete for a \$5000 grant at Arvada Vitality Alliance's annual event (Arvada Hilton Garden Inn) on May 5 between 6:00 and 9:00 pm. Young RYLA: Arvada Rotarians: We have requested 2 RYLA and 2 YRYLA positions for 2018. I have confirmed our interest in these positions with the RYLA Coordinator. Each slot is \$450 (for either age level) and \$1800.00 payment is due March 15th.

RYLA, Young RYLA, and RYLA Plus applications open

Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) is a life-changing leadership training program for young men and women. Leadership skills and principles are learned, developed, and enhanced in an atmosphere of trust and respect. The purpose of these conferences is to encourage and assist current and potential youth leaders in methods of responsible and effective leadership. The application and review schedule is, as follows:

April 30: Application period ENDS

May 15: Interviews and selection completed. Completed RYLA applications must be submitted.

May 30: Completed Young RYLA applications must be submitted.

RYLA Conferences (held at YMCA of the Rockies, Estes Park, CO)

Applicants must be *current high school sophomores or juniors*, and must be able to stay all 5 days of conference.

RYLA 1: Sunday, July 15 through Friday, July 20, 2018.

RYLA 2: Sunday, July 22 through Friday, July 27, 2018.

Young RYLA Camps (held at Ponderosa Retreat & Conference Center, Larkspur, CO)

Applicants must be *current 7th grader* to apply, and must be able to stay all 5 days of camp.

Young RYLA Camp-1: July 22 - 27, 2018

Young RYLA Camp-2: July 29 - August 3, 2018

RYLA Plus Camp (physically-challenged teens)(held at Easter Seals' Rocky Mountain Village, Empire, CO)

RYLA Plus: Sunday, July 8 - Friday, July 13, 2018

He was one of the nicest , soft spoken men we have had in the club. He is survived by his (*at the time of his Presidency in Rotary Rotary-Ann*), Phyliss and daughters Tammy Yonkie and Vicki Wolf
