### **How do I shop at AmazonSmile?**

### **Can I use my existing Amazon.com account on AmazonSmile?**

## **KRAMER'S CORNER:**

Here is the latest item **Rich Kramer** has sent me. This is the latest news on how the Colorado Garden & Home Show Foundation spent some to the funds that passed through our hands at the ticket booths of the Garden Show in February and the Fall Home show.

CGFH members spent two days and traveled 1100 miles interviewing candidates for its scholarship program. After narrowing a list of candidates to two finalists, the board decided to award full scholarships to both to attend CSU. Mr. Fricke said, "...we simply could not decide between these two outstanding candidates. These two talented and deserving students will do great things in the fields of agriculture and horticulture in the years to come". Proceeds from the Garden Show and Home Show make the scholarships possible. Scholarships and grants in 2017 totaled \$706,813 and more than \$7.8 million across the state to date.

Our Club has a part to make possible CGFH's giving of scholarships and grants.
