She pointed out the importance for professionals and the community to work on strategies and promotion of well-being, as well as to search and provide for effec services. Such services should promote well being and security for children, allo reach their full human potential, and strive to achieve general health standards for All of these services are of value to a functioning society.

Suzanne also pointed out that even though the Australian statistics on youth mer cause for concern, yet only 7% of the mental health dollar services children, and in the area is slipping slightly backwards.
