

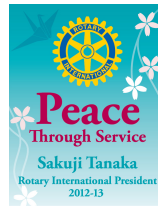

SERGEANT SESSION. Michael continued his series of Nominated Best Music, talking back rather than play music. The selection by Roger harked back to the ‘Gas Man Cometh’.

GUEST SPEAKER- Judith Sloan. "Should the Fair Work Act be replaced?" Prof Judith Sloan is Honorary Professorial Fellow at the Melbourne Institute of Applied Science and Technology. She has held numerous commercial directorships. Previously, she was a Professor of Labour Studies at The Flinders University of South Australia and a columnist. She is now a columnist with “The Australian”.

The Fair Work Act establishes a National Industrial Relations System with National Industrial Relations Commission and provisions protecting individuals. It draws on the corporatist architecture of Work Choices but without some of what she saw were good bits of it.

Prof Sloan argued that the impacts on large and small employers were different with the legislation and she noted that there were 15,000 unfair dismissal complaints. Unfair dismissal was “fuzzy” and it would be better framed as “illegal dismissal”. (Note that “unreasonable” dismissal and provides criteria to assist in considering harshness)

Her proposed way forward is 3 statutes (rather than one), which would cover:

- Minimum standards;
- Industrial agreements; and
- Individual grievances

Chairman Mik thanked Prof Sloan and presented her with a token gift of soap in appreciation. President Kay closed the meeting.
