RCCM-S provided seed funding for this project some time ago through Sunny Fong. Sunny was back in Australia for 2 months until mid May launching a review of the Board of Directors. Sunny Water can more effectively meet the challenges presented by the continued growth of the country. He met with ACTEW, iCognition and Hall Rotary to discuss their ongoing support and have now renewed their support for the next year.

Sunny is now back in Lao until mid July continuing the transition to the locally based team. Abundant Water welcomes Mac Maness to the team. Mac is beginning to set up the compound and introducing systems to increase the efficiency and output of the team. There are now four Lao employees on the team. The AW compound team continues to develop the AW technology and system to enable ongoing roll-out to villages. Issues currently being investigated are different burn-out materials, production efficiencies and adapting to greater storage volume, such as in schools.
