Liza McDonald will be commenting on how to be **MAKING OUR TAXIS BETTER**

The Taxi Services Commission is the new regulator of the taxi industry, taking over from the Victorian Taxi Directorate. The Victorian Government recently announced major reforms for Victoria's taxi industry, following the Taxi Industry Inquiry led by Professor Allan Fels.

The government has claimed that the reforms will create a more flexible, responsive and innovative taxi industry that provides

better service and safety for customers. Key changes include improved conditions for drivers, an independent "knowledge" exam for new drivers, a new fare structure, removing restrictions on the number of new taxi licences and encouraging more disability accessible vehicles.

Major industry players have supported some reforms however significant resistance to the proposed reforms has been exhibited by certain industry participants. Liza's presentation will provide some details relating to the background of the reforms as well as outlining where to from here.

Liza McDonald was the Director of Reform Policy and Engagement Strategy within the Taxi Industry Inquiry. She has now taken up the position Director of Industry Reform Implementation within the newly formed Taxi Services Commission. Liza has been at the grass roots of the taxi industry reforms since day one and she has a wealth of knowledge to share on the topic.

The Guest Speaker was Anne Fairhall, well known to many in the Club.

Anne has cared for Geoff who has suffered from steadily worsening dementia over the last 8 years. Anne described how the disease, Fronto Temporal Lobar Degeneration (FTLD) in Geoff's case, developed slowly and that given his high level of native intelligence Geoff was able to compensate for many years before his functionality was seriously impaired and he acknowledged that all was not well. Some will recall Geoff spoke to the Club well

after he had been diagnosed to explain to us what was happening to him.

FTLD is one of several forms of dementia and is less common that Alzheimer's disease which represents about 70% of all dementia cases.

Anne described how the disease profoundly affects the life of both the patient and their family and carers in so many ways, grief at losing touch with a loved one, the indignity, fear of the unknown, the intrusion at home of essential support services, etc.

It is a terminal disease, is irreversible, medications only serving to retard its development or deal with the symptoms. As a carer there are major challenges in learning how to best cope with apparently irrational behaviours whilst maintaining genuine communication with the sufferer. Anne spoke well of several support groups including Carers Victoria, Alzheimer's Victoria, the Health and Aging Service of the City of Melbourne. She has personally taken a strong interest in promoting better understanding of the complexities of a diagnosis of dementia and the complex care needs and is a member of Alzheimer's Australia (Vic) Consumer Advisory Committee.
