Professor Euan Wallace AM

"Safer Care Victoria – Its Foundation and Priorities"

Safer Care Victoria works with patients and health services to take a patient-centred approach to quality and safety improvement. The goal is zero avoidable harm and best possible health outcomes. It supports health services to improve patient outcomes and achieve the common goal of zero avoidable harm using an integrated approach of surveillance, prevention, and repair.

Safer Care Victoria helps health services to improve quality and safety for individual clinicians, in health services and system-wide. It creates linkages, partnerships and shared learning across Victorian health services, highlighting the many examples of best practice that exist in our diverse services.

The organisation has a strong focus on listening to patients and clinicians, ensuring that patients and patient outcomes remain at the centre of safety and quality initiatives.

Professor Euan Wallace was appointed as the inaugural Chief Executive Officer of Safer Care Victoria in October 2016. Safer Care Victoria is leading quality and safety improvement in Victorian public and private health services. He is a senior clinician with an extensive track record in academic medicine and health service delivery. Graduating from the Edinburgh Medical School, Professor Wallace completed his research and clinical training in Edinburgh before moving to Australia and joining Monash Health and Monash University in 1996.
