

## Scholarship Application Guideline - 2022

This year, the Rotary Club of Southwick will present **one (1)** scholarship in the amount of **\$3000** (payable for one year) **IN HONOR OF;**

**Helen Nadeau, Retired First Grade Teacher, Woodland School, Southwick, Massachusetts.**

*The scholarship is payable the second semester of the first year of college or training and must be claimed for by May 1 of the academic year. Award is made payable directly to the college/university. To initiate payment, Rotary must have copies of student's 2<sup>nd</sup> semester bill, transcript of grades, and letter of enrollment.*

- Scholarship will be based on **academics** for students attending an accredited university, college, or community college.

### Eligibility

- The candidate must be a current year graduating senior from Southwick Regional school or -
- The candidate must be a Southwick resident and a current year graduating senior from an accredited high school or technical school outside of the Southwick school district
- or
- The candidate must be a graduate of Southwick Regional School who has delayed their advanced or formal education to a later date but no longer than five years from their graduation.

### Criteria

Candidates will be evaluated based on the following:

- Participation in school and community service projects
  - Character, integrity and high ethical standards
  - Academic or vocational/technical excellence
  - Financial need **Requirements**
  - Letter of recommendation from a Southwick Regional School teacher, administrator or a community business leader
  - **Essay** relating to Rotary's motto of "***Service above Self***"
  - Information on school and community service projects – can be part of essay.
  - Completed application form.
