- Fighting Disease

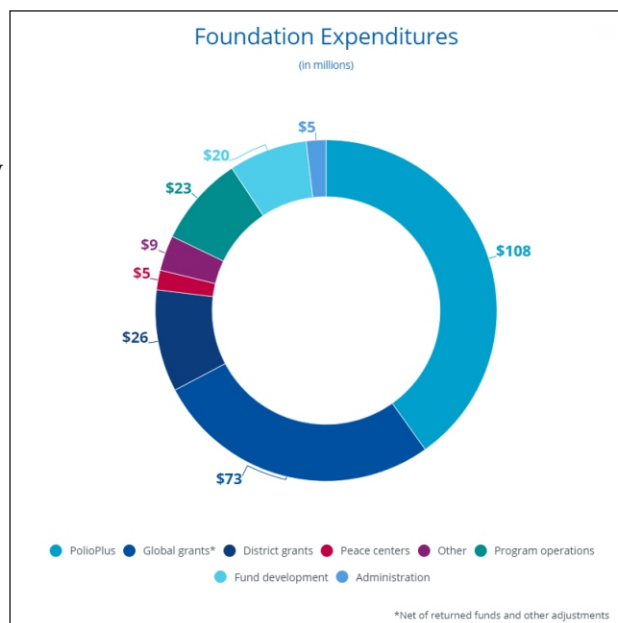
### How does The Rotary Foundation use donations?

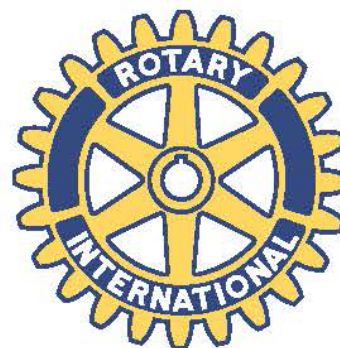
