2024 Scholarship Application

The Rotary Club of Freeport is accepting applications for up to four scholarships available to high school seniors **graduating in 2024 and entering college in the 2024-25 academic year.** Because of Rotary's focus on service, the award recognizes outstanding community service and academic excellence, as well as leadership and other student activities.

About the Scholarship and Eligibility

Up to four (4) scholarships of \$500 - \$2,000, will be awarded to students going on to 4-year academic college and university programs or a 1 or 2-year technical program or academic program. **To be eligible, students must be residents of Freeport, Durham or Pownal.** Freeport Rotary members and their immediate family members are not eligible. Students awarded scholarships will receive the funds during their second college/program semester upon receipt by the Rotary Club of Freeport of their first semester satisfactory grades. The scholarships may be applied to tuition, books, housing, transportation or other college expenses.

Application Requirements

In addition to community service and academic achievement, financial need is considered in the awarding of these scholarships. Information required from students for this application includes: (1) school academic records, (2) family FAFSA score, (3) colleges/schools applied to and any acceptances, (4) projected education costs, (5) at least two letters of recommendation, (6) answers to application questions in essay format and, (7) a resume.

How to Apply and Application Deadline

Scholarship applications are available on the Rotary Club of Freeport web site at www.freeport-rotary.org, from guidance offices at area public or private schools or by writing to Karen O'Rourke at orourkekaren7@gmail.com.

The deadline for application is April 1, 2024.

All applications must be electronic in a single pdf that includes all required information.
