Home Repairs Program

GOAL: To empower seniors with limited means who wish to age in their homes by providing necessary repairs to make their homes safer, warmer, and drier at no cost.

PURPOSE: To organize skilled volunteers, plan projects, provide materials, and complete repairs or improvements at no cost to eligible seniors so that they may safely remain in their homes.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Rotary Home Repair Program is partnering with Freeport Community Services' "Aging Friendly Freeport/Pownal," a community-led consortium of organizations collaborating to foster initiatives that help people thrive while aging as well as with local police, fire, EMT, and the towns of Pownal and Durham.
- Like other Maine communities statewide, Freeport Rotary has established a home repair team to support seniors who wish to remain in their homes but cannot do repair work themselves or to pay for modifications needed to make their homes safe, warm, and dry. Freeport Rotary's Home Repair Program is modeled after those supported by the Maine Council on Aging and the many Habitats for Humanity affiliates throughout the State.
- Project examples include constructing ramps, repairing steps and decks, winterizing homes, and installing grab bars and smoke detectors.

Others who may be eligible for repairs in particular instances are low-income disabled individuals or veterans.

We seek projects, donations, materials, tools, and volunteers to assist in this initiative. Volunteers with knowledge and experience in the building trades and those with handyman skills are particularly needed, but everyone is welcome.
