Jerry Johnson Trust Matching Program Update #9

It was another relatively slow week. We had 7 new donors over the past 7 days and \$3,555 in new contributions. To date, 145 Rotarians representing 35 of our 57 clubs have contributed a total of \$62,288! These contributions continue to result in recognition as all but 7 of the 138 contributors have reached a new Paul Harris Fellow level as the result of their participation.
