The Flamingos of Change

On February 2, 2019, 400 Rotarians and friends gathered for dinner at the Austin Hilton to celebrate the District's support to The Rotary Foundation in Calendar Year 2018. The attendees experienced an uncommon treat, as Rotary International President Barry Rassin served as the guest speaker; it is not every day that the RI President visits an event in one of Rotary's 539 individual Districts!

President Rassin shared amazing stories about our progress towards polio eradication, the importance of the Rotary Peace Fellows program, how work within our Areas of Focus helps bring peace to the world, and how Rotary was the first organization to respond to the earthquake in Haiti. He challenged us, as Rotarians, to think bigger - to find even more ways to have impact on our communities and the world.

Finally, he described the cover photo from the July 2018 issue of The Rotarian Magazine to the audience. In that picture, Rassin and his wife Esther are standing in front of seven flamingos, six of which face left, and the seventh faces right.
