Proposal and Motion to Raise Dues and Breakfast Fees

The Proposal and Motion to increase the weekly breakfast to \$15/member and the annual dues to \$200/member has passed overwhelmingly. Here are the reasons for these increases:

Breakfast - The club charges each attending Rotarian \$12. In turn, the club is billed by BCC \$12/attendee. The club incurs a deficit of about \$4,600 annually for Teacher/Paraprofessional, Bluebonnet MHMR, Scholarships and other complimentary breakfasts. If we increase the cost to \$15, we should "raise" somewhere close to \$9,000. This will give us a cushion of approximately \$4,400.

Club Dues - The dues have not been increased in over 10 years. The club experiences an annual operating shortfall of approximately \$5,000. If we increase our club dues to \$200, we should increase our revenue by \$4,500. This will close the gap.
