

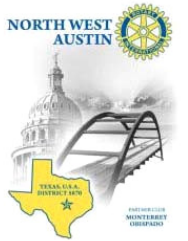

In 2011, Adam and four co-founders started Austin Beerworks. This year, ABW will produce and self-distribute ~22,000 barrels, which is nearly 7.4 million pints of beer. Adam is also the Board Vice-Chair of the Texas Craft Brewers Guild, advocating fixes to antiquated beer regulations that inhibit and cap how much growth is possible for Texas craft breweries. One of the fastest growing segments of our economy, the Craft Brewing Industry Contributed \$67.8 Billion to the U.S. economy and more than 456,000 Jobs in 2016. On August 1, 2018, D5870 began matching contributions for this Limited Time Offer. For a number of years, the Jerry Johnson Trust has been asked if there is any way that the Trust can match contributions made by Rotarians who are already a Paul Harris Fellow.
