

Jerry Johnson Trust Matching Program Update #7

It was another AMAZING week! I continue to marvel at the generosity of District 5870 Rotarians. We had 14 new donors over the past 7 days and \$6,725 in new contributions. To date, 131 Rotarians representing 33 of our 57 clubs have contributed a total of \$56,208! These contributions continue to result in recognition as all but 6 of the 131 contributors have reached a new Paul Harris Fellow level as the result of their participation.

Update: There was one change in the leader board this week.

• 1st Place: Rotary Club of Austin (\$7,900)

2nd Place: Rotary Club of Pflugerville (\$6,235)
3rd Place: Rotary Club of Waco (\$3,555)

3rd Place: Rotary Club of Waco (\$3,555)

• 4th Place: Rotary Club of West Austin (\$3,000) (passing Lakeway) Please remember that the winner of this race will receive 1,000 Foundation Recognition Points to distribute as they see fit.

The match will continue until we run out of points. As of today, a little over 70% of the match pool has been used, and we estimate that the pool will be used up sometime in mid-to-late October.

As a refresher, District 5870 is offering the following to any Rotarian who is already a Paul Harris Fellow but not yet a Paul Harris Fellow +8, on a first come, first served basis. Using a pool of Foundation Recognition Points, we will match contributions of new cash made to the Annual Fund-SHARE during Rotary Year 2019-20 on a 1-to-1 basis in amounts of \$250 to \$500 for any active Rotarian in District 5870 who is not yet a Paul Harris Fellow +8.

Hope Presbyterian Church as already committed to funding half of the memorial water site, \$3000. NWARC members now are invited to make a donation for this memorial. It is easily done:

- 1. Donate, a check, to the Annual Fund of "The Rotary Foundation" for your account. You will get your contribution matched, receive Paul Harris credit for the total, and the project will get the amount of your donation credited to the water site. Checks must be given to Taylor "Tad" Turpin on Friday, Sept 20 through October 30, after which they will be sent to The Rotary Foundation.
- Donate, a check, to North West Austin Rotary Club, "for water site" on the line, and it will go directly to the fund for the water site and it will be matched for at least 50%.
