

TRF Facts - Did you know?

- 1,783 of the 2,641 members of our District (67.5%) are Paul Harris Fellows.
- 146 of our members are Major Donors (5.5%); 56 are Bequest Society members (2.1%).
- 838 of our members (31.7%) are eligible to take advantage of the Jerry Johnson Trust Match Program to earn their first Paul Harris Fellowship.
- 212 members (8.1%) have never contributed to The Rotary Foundation, 157 of which (74.1%) joined Rotary in the past two years. (We are hoping to convince them of the good that our Foundation does around the world so that they will make a donation to the Foundation in its 100th year.)
- 21 of our 62 clubs (33.9%) have earned the 100% Paul Harris Fellowship Club Banner: 5 of them (8.1%) have earned the banner twice; 1 of them (RC of Yoakum) has earned the banner three times.
